World-renowned forensic anthropologist Bill Bass is the founder and former director of The Forensic Anthropology Center (FAC) at the University of Tennessee Knoxville. Known colloquially as “The Body Farm,” the FAC is the world’s only laboratory devoted to the study of human decomposition.

Along with Jon Jefferson, Dr. Bass is the author of the best-selling Body Farm mystery novels, the latest of which is “The Inquisitor’s Key,” released in May 2012. Dr. Bass is also the author or co-author of more than 200 scientific articles, as well as a critically acclaimed memoir about his career titled “Death’s Acre.” Also a dedicated teacher, Dr. Bass has been honored as National Professor of the Year by the Council for Advancement and Support of Education.
